

DIRECTIONS TO THE UNION COUNTY GOVERNMENT CENTER

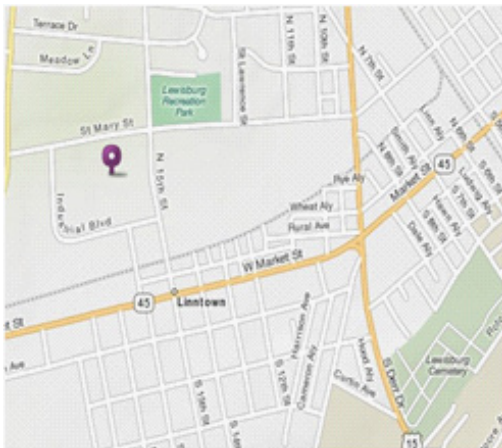
15 South
